## A CULTURE OF AWARENESS

"I can do something about stalking."

**89%** agree or strongly agree that **asking for sexual consent reduces any misinterpretations** that might arise

**83%** indicated that sexual consent should **always be obtained before the start of any sexual activity**

**88%** agree or strongly agree that they **feel confident** about asking for consent from their current partner

## FUTURE RECOMMENDATIONS:

Harassment and Gender Violence training will now be offered to fraternities and sororities every two years and in a rotation with a number of other athletic teams, organizations, and clubs.
