Base Camp fosters authentic dialogue, while allowing participants to develop meaningful relationships and support networks to aid them in creating positive change during their fraternity and sorority community experience.

On September 9-11, 2016, 51 fraternity and sorority leaders attended Base Camp to develop these skills. 69% responded to the assessment. Here is their story.
