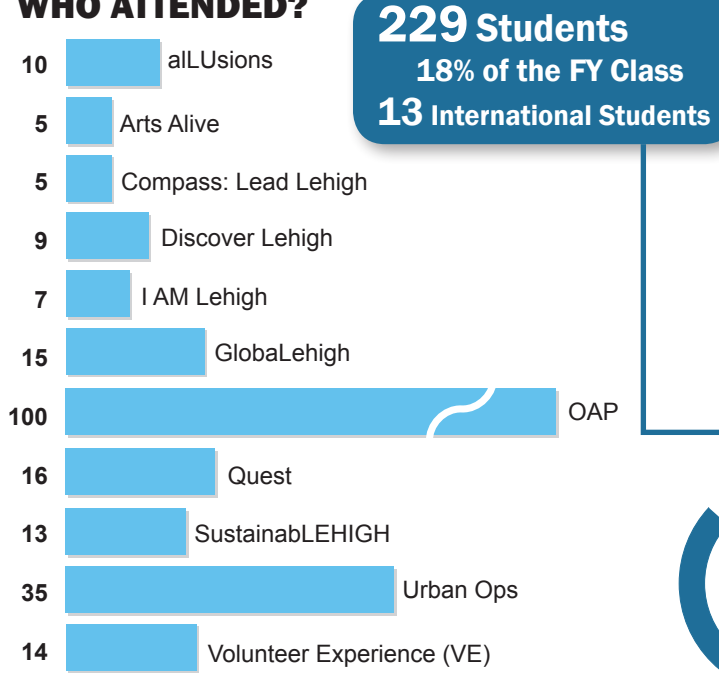

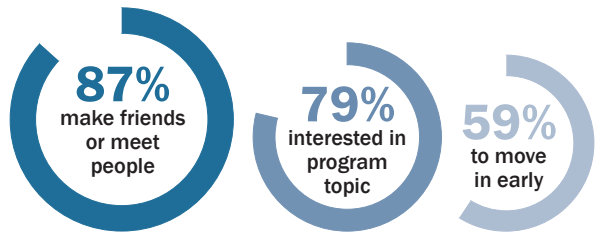
WHO ATTENDED?



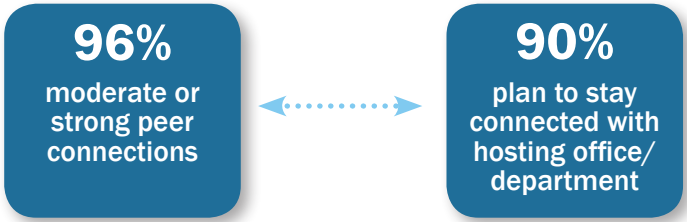
229 Students

STUDENTS PLANNED TO STAY CONNECTED TO THE HOST OFFICE/DEPARTMENTS BY:

- 73% Attending programs they offer
- 51% Joining organization connected to topic area of program
- 29% Working or volunteering in the office
- 10% Do not plan to stay connected

AFTER FIRST SEMESTER, STUDENTS HAVE STAYED CONNECTED TO HOST OFFICE/DEPARTMENT BY:

- 37% Attending programs they offer
- 17% Joining organization connected to topic area of program



OTHER NOTES...

96% of attendees would recommend their program to other new students

- In regard to meeting more students, **76%** of students found the evening socials very or somewhat helpful
- **38%** of FYS indicated a sports/fitness/nutrition related Prelusion program would interest them



MONEY MATERS

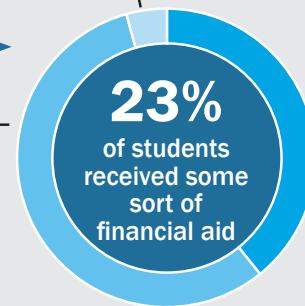
