


• 96% of the staff can articulate the responsibilities of their position and are confident they can fulfill the role in its entirety.


- Staff is more confident in their ability to facilitate activities (82%) than facilitating discussions (70%).

f 38% of OFYE staff somewhat or strongly agreed they know structu of Lehigh Administrators.


