

Dean of Students Summer Internship

The Dean of Students Office is a functional area within the Student Affairs Division. Under the leadership of the Associate Vice Provost and Dean of Students, this office seeks to:

Dean of Students Summer Intern Responsibilities

Under the supervision of the Director of Planning & Assessment, Jess Manno, the intern will work for 11 weeks, between May 26, 2014 and August 8, 2014 and will perform the following responsibilities:

- Work approximately 20 hours/per week to assist in the ongoing efforts of the Dean of Students Office;
- Schedule and meet with the Vice Provost for Student Affairs, the Dean of Students Leadership Team, and selected Dean of Students Staff members based on future intern interest areas;
- Administratively support and assist with annual summer projects (DOS strategic plan compiling, academic support file purging, updating DOS handbook, sending Dean's List certificates, etc.);
- Monitor, update and expand the reach of the DOS social media platforms with information relevant to students at Lehigh during the summer months;
- Work with identified offices within the Dean of Students department on a variety of assorted projects to support the overall efforts of the department and the summer needs of the individual areas within the Dean of Students area;
- > Specific projects will be determined and identified throughout the spring semester through a combination of departmental needs and intern interest and skill areas;
- Other duties as assigned.
