Alpha Gamma Delta	January 28, 2022	<p>An anonymous report alleged that a member of the chapter engaging in conduct constituting brutality of a mental nature.</p> <p>Result of investigation: both Lehigh University Police Department and the Office of Student Conduct interviewed students. No students interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	February 7, 2022
2.	Lehigh University Football Team	February 4, 2022	<p>A parent of a first year member of the football team called the Dean of Students Office to share concerns related to expectations of team members, specifically alleging that players were expected to practice at 5am outside, even during the winter.</p> <p>Result of investigation: Lehigh University Police Department interviewed members of the team and staff. No one interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	February 18, 2022

3.	Pi Beta Phi	February 13, 2022	<p>An anonymous hazing report was filed alleging that members were engaging in conduct constituting brutality of a mental nature.</p> <p>Result of investigation: both Lehigh University Police Department and the Office of Student Conduct interviewed multiple students, including chapter leadership. No students interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	February 18, 2022
4.	Alpha Tau Omega	March 26, 2022	<p>An anonymous hazing report was filed alleging that the chapter was requiring new member activities after the six week cut off and that the chapter was conducting multiple "line ups" every week.</p> <p>Result of investigation: both Lehigh University Police Department and the Office of Student Conduct interviewed multiple students, including chapter leadership. No students interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	April 11, 2022
5.	Phi Sigma Kappa	March 31, 2022	<p>The fraternity chapter filed a report stating that current members conducted a "roast" of new members, which appeared to be conduct constituting brutality of a mental nature.</p> <p>Result of investigation: the chapter was charged with and found responsible for providing false information and violation of posted rules and regulations. The chapter was also charged with hazing, and found not responsible by the University Committee on Discipline.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: disciplinary probation through May 31, 2023 and educational sanctions.</p>	April 18, 2022	May 2, 2022
6.	Chi Psi	March 31, 2022	<p>An anonymous hazing report alleged that several new members had endured brutality of a physical nature due to hazing.</p> <p>Result of investigation: both Lehigh University Police Department and the Office of Student Conduct interviewed multiple students, including chapter leadership. No students interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	April 18, 2022

7.	Delta Chi	April 4, 2022	<p>An anonymous hazing report alleged that the chapter had subjected new members to brutality of a physical and mental nature and required them to consume food in a manner subjecting the new members to emotional and/or physical harm.</p> <p>Result of investigation: both Lehigh University Police Department and the Office of Student Conduct interviewed multiple students, including chapter leadership. No students interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	April 18, 2022
8.	Alpha Tau Omega	April 24, 2022	<p>An anonymous hazing report alleged that the chapter was conducting "lineups" that night, and that they might be playing music to cover up screams of members being initiated. When Lehigh University Police investigated at the campus chapter house, they found evidence of hazing, including chairs which had a topical analgesic cream rubbed into the seats, and students knocking over the chairs and running out the side door of the house. The students were dishonest with police and the Office of Student Conduct during the investigation.</p> <p>Result of investigation: the chapter was charged with and found responsible for hazing, providing false information, and causing an emergency.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: disciplinary dissolution through May 31, 2026</p>	June 14, 2022	June 30, 2022
9.	Phi Sigma Kappa	April 25, 2022	<p>Lehigh University Police Department responded to the intersection of Morton and Buchanan Streets to assist Bethlehem Police who were speaking with a student who was attempting to steal a sign. Bethlehem Police believed the conduct may be part of a scavenger hunt conducted by a Lehigh fraternity.</p> <p>Result of investigation: both Lehigh University Police Department and the Office of Student Conduct interviewed multiple students, including chapter leadership. No students interviewed had any knowledge related to the allegations.</p> <p>Penalties imposed: None, no charges filed in this case.</p>	N/A	May 9, 2022
