August 8, 2019	<p>It was reported by an anonymous individual who identified as a recent graduate of Lehigh University that unnamed Greek organizations were using/misusing alcohol and putting significant pressure on first year students to attend social events in order to gain membership into the chapters.</p> <p>Result of investigation: The investigation did not result in sufficient credible information to proceed with a formal conduct process for any chapter. Each chapter was sent a letter of warning. This picture was taken in the Alpha Tau Omega kitchen.</p> <p>Result of investigation: Alpha Tau Omega has been charged with hazing, unauthorized distribution of alcohol, irresponsible distribution of alcohol, and encouraging others to violate the Code. 3	Pi Beta Phi	December 5, 2019	<p>The Office of Fraternity & Sorority Affairs was informed that the national office of Pi Beta Phi put the local chapter on investigative status while an investigation into hazing allegations was conducted. The activities were reported by chapter members, according to the national office.</p> <p>Result of investigation: Pi Beta Phi has been charged with hazing, unauthorized possession/consumption/distribution of alcohol, irresponsible distribution of alcohol, and providing false information.
