MenACWY vaccine

Recommended for 11-12 year olds, plus important booster shot at 16

MOST HAVE RECEIVED



MenB vaccine

Suggested for 16-23 year olds, preferably 16-18 year olds

FEW HAVE RECEIVED

Meningococcal disease can often occur **WITHOUT WARNING** and can **KILL** in a matter of **HOURS**
