### When & How To Join

- First-year students are eligible to join a fraternity or sorority in the spring semester (deferred recruitment) after acclimating to campus.
  - Allows students time to adjust to academic environment
  - Allows students the opportunity explore options and make informed decisions
- Council-coordinated for IFC and Panhellenic recruitment processes.
- Students interested in participating in intake must express interest with the desired CGC organization(s).

\* Deferred Recruitment - Lehigh University is of the philosophy that in order to join a fraternity or sorority, a student will have successfully completed a full time schedule of 12 credit hours or more and achieved a 2.500 GPA or higher.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. 12 Lehigh Credits (*AP credits do not apply*)
- 2. 2.500 cumulative GPA
  - a. Individual chapters may have a higher GPA requirement
- 3. No serious offenses with alcohol
- 4. Participation in Greek Recruitment 5x10
