Accreditation Report 2022-2023

Leadership & Member Development

- Chi Phi cultivates strong leadership skills, encourages a sense of belonging, promotes lasting friendships, and
 provides a comprehensive experience for all members. The fraternity's values are centered on developing
 better men through truth, honor, and personal integrity. Members can contribute to the mission through
 various leadership positions.
- The fraternity follows a formal process for electing new officers. This process includes a shadowing program, officer meetings with the Chi Phi HQ advisor, and Briarfield meetings with alums.
- Chi Phi has a diversity, equity, and inclusion plan that includes DEI meetings, gender violence training, diversity peer educators, and LGBTQ+ support education.
- Chi Phi places great importance on Continuing Membership Education, reflected in their wide range of seminars and presentations. These cover mental health, hazing prevention, water sustainability, CPR training, and a seminar collaborating with RAINN to help men become better individuals.
- There is a high level of involvement among the members of Chi Phi on campus, with a significant 77% of them participating in other organizations. These organizations span various domains, such as sports clubs, cultural societies, and academic groups. The members are dedicated to exploring diverse interests and making the most of their time on campus.

Chapter Development Questions for 2023-2024:

- What steps can Chi Phi take to improve its New Member Education program to foster a greater appreciation for diversity, equity, and inclusion and actively empower new members to support Chi Phi's mission?
- How can Chi Phi enhance member engagement, campus organization, and club participation? This will help to strengthen the sense of community and provide more leadership opportunities. What strategies can be implemented to achieve this goal?
- How can Chi Phi enhance its Continuing Membership Education program to cover more crucial subjects and equip its members with valuable abilities and knowledge to aid them in their personal and professional lives beyond the organization, such as mental health practices, career development, and financial awareness seminars or workshops?

In the area of Leadership & Member Development, the committee rated Chi Phi to be an Accredited with Excellence Chapter.

Organizational Operations

- Chi Phi fraternity has improved its recruitment over the past two years through values-based recruitment, increased training for recruitment officers, inclusive efforts, and fall new member recruitment.
- In fall 2022, the fraternity recruited six new members, the second-largest among IFC fraternities, and in spring 2023, it recruited 25 new members, the second-largest among IFC fraternities.
- Various events were organized during formal recruitment, including virtual meetings, pool, poker, and closed dinners with potential new members. Additionally, three open events were held in the fall semester.
- The chapter's financial status is strong because they have managed to stay within their budget. They also receive a 5% discount on insurance and reduced member dues by making timely payments.
- In addition, they schedule weekly reports and biweekly meetings with the national financial advisor. The Standards Board promotes accountability by holding brothers responsible with fair consequences during their weekly meetings. It's worth noting that monetary penalties are no longer in place.
- Communication is consistent and occurs with national and alumni advisors through social media platforms, Google Calendar, and Drive.

- The chapter completed Chi Phi HQ's accreditation process and received five awards at the National Congress, which included the Outstanding Community Service Award and the William M. Byrd Alumnus of the Year award.
- The chapter's IHQ advisor helps set yearly goals and objectives. The fraternity surpassed its recruitment goal of four PNMs by recruiting six new members during the fall.

Chapter Development Questions for 2023-2024:

- What steps can Chi Phi take to enhance its recruitment strategies and consistently attract new members, ultimately improving its ranking among IFC fraternities?
- What other strategies can Chi Phi adopt to improve financial management, increase savings, reduce dependence on external sources, and ensure the long-term stability of the chapter?
- What can Chi Phi take to improve its communication methods and platforms to effectively and efficiently share information, engage members, and involve alums in chapter activities?
- To reach a 10% savings target for unexpected expenses, what actions can Chi Phi take to enhance its financial management?

In the area of **Organizational Operations**, the committee rated Chi Phi to be an **Accredited with Excellence Chapter**.

Community Service & Engagement

- The Chi Phi fraternity strongly emphasizes community service and philanthropy, which the Philanthropy Chair and Co-Chair oversee.
- The required service hours have been increased from 10 to 15. It's worth noting that 96% of brothers have successfully met this requirement, while 54% have even exceeded it.
- The fraternity aims to match its charitable work with Chi Phi's mission and values, benefiting the community and its members' personal growth.
- The fraternity engages in community service activities such as weekly tutoring, Southside Cleanup, Adopt a Highway, and Wagner Farms Giving Garden.
- The organization works with other student groups to hold charitable events, partnering with Lambda Theta Alpha and Investment Management Group. They have hosted effective fundraisers for Rare Disease Day and assisted the family of Juan Robles, a custodian affected by a hurricane in Puerto Rico.
- The fraternity takes part in both Lehigh University and Greek organization events. They also work with non-Greek organizations and have organized or participated in various events, including Relay for Life, Spring Fling, Chi Phi Against Drunk Driving, and Narcan donations.

In the area of Community Service & Engagement, the committee rated Chi Phi to be an Accredited with Excellence Chapter.

Academic & Intellectual Advancement

Chi Phi was ranked 7 out of 11 fraternities in the fall 2022 semester with a GPA of 3.21, an increase of 0.01 from the spring 2022 semester. The 3.22 GPA placed the chapter below All Greek, All Fraternity and All IFC averages.

- Chi Phi was ranked 6 out of 10 in the spring 2023 semester with a GPA of 3.30 an increase of .09 from the fall 2022 semester. The 3.30 GPA placed the chapter below All Greek, All Fraternity and All IFC averages.
- Chi Phi's fall 2022 new member class GPA was 2.62 ranking 4 out of 5 chapters taking new members on the Interfraternity Council.
- Chi Phi's spring 2023 new member class GPA was 3.28 ranking 5 out of 10 of chapters on the Interfraternity Council.
- Chi Phi had 30% of the chapter on the Dean's List in the fall 2022 semester and 37.3% on the Dean's List in the spring 2023 semester.
- To provide individualized support for members struggling academically, the fraternity has created an Academic Board led by a Chairman and two Members. They offer a range of resources, including access to study rooms, tutoring services, and assistance tailored to specific majors.
- The Chi Phi Educational Trust Scholarship Program annually offers more than \$200,000 scholarships to brothers and chapters. The fraternity has awarded scholarships to recipients for four years in a row.
- To encourage academic excellence, the fraternity provides rewards such as an academic dinner for brothers who achieve above-average GPAs and scholarships for those who attain the highest GPA and most improved GPA. GPA is considered as a factor in the distribution of house points.
- The fraternity has a high success rate in maintaining good relationships with its alumni, as 70% respond to their communications. They organize events for alumni networking and have an active LinkedIn group with 100 members.
- Additionally, they provide various opportunities for career development, including resume workshops, fireside chats with accomplished alumni, financial career discussions, and an annual golf tournament for alumni.
- In addition, the fraternity offers valuable networking and career development resources. These include updated career and contact information for alumni, a high employment rate for graduating seniors, and hands-on learning opportunities for juniors and sophomores. Moreover, members can benefit from mock interviews with senior brothers, which can help them prepare for future job interviews.

- How can the chapter improve academic performance and raise the cumulative GPA ranking among IFC fraternities?
- How can the chapter enhance its support systems and resources for brothers facing academic challenges?

In the area of Academic & Intellectual Development, the committee rated Chi Phi to be an Accredited Chapter.

Facilities Management

- Chi Phi had no common damages for the 2022-2023 academic year.
- Chi Phi had no issues with openings or closings for the 2022-2023 academic year.
- Chi Phi had one major life safety violation in the fall 2022 semester due to a smoke detector being covered.
- Chi Phi had no major life safety violations for the spring 2023 semester.
- communicated with Housing Services effectively and completed tasks in a timely manner.
- Facilities management efforts include thorough due diligence, timely key pickups, room inspections, and regular communication with housing services.
- The fraternity saw an increase in the number of brothers living in the house and dealt with individual accountability using the Standards Board to handle minor violations.
- Sustainability initiatives include the replacement of plastic utensils with reusable metal silverware, reducing styrofoam usage, scheduling sustainability workshops, and using greener appliances.

- The fraternity considers hosting dinner guests, especially important members of the Lehigh community, an
 ongoing tradition they continue to uphold.
- House projects focus on creating a professional interview room, addressing flooring issues, installing LED lighting for energy efficiency, and making minor improvements such as appliance replacements and bathroom renovations.
- The fraternity received positive feedback for caring for staff and the facility, contributing to a better living environment.

- What strategies can improve communication and collaboration between chapter members and housing services?
