Description of the Big/Little Process

Existing members who do not already have their own little sister will be eligible to become big sisters for the new member class. Any member that wants to take place in the big/little process will be paired with a big/little regardless of numbers. If the number of new members exceeds the number of available big sisters then two new members will be assigned to a big sister. The director of new member education will host a meeting to all potential big sisters to ensure that they are aware of the ritual and other responsibilities of becoming a big sister. At this meeting big/little pairing preference forms will also be distributed.
