Conserve Energy

- · Use cold water when doing your laundry.
- Rent a MicroFridge and purchase only ENERGY STAR labeled electronics (TV, DVD player).
- Buy an <u>EPEAT-rated</u> computer.



Don't Buy So Much Stuff

- Create more open space by eliminating duplication
- Wait to buy shelves, rugs, lamps, and other accessories until you see what fits in the room.



Live Healthier and Be Green

- Buy snacks in bulk because they use less packaging.
- Bring your bike or join the Zagster bike share program!
- Join Lehigh's carshare program!



Recycle & Reuse

- Learn what can and cannot be recycled at Lehigh.
- Before you pack, consider packing items in reusable plastic bins or empty cardboard boxes from your grocer.
- Buy school supplies made of recycled, post-consumer, FSC-certified, or otherwise green materials.
- Bring a reusable water bottle, reusable coffee mug, and reusable cloth bags from home.



Eco-Friendly Products

- Bring eco-friendly soaps and detergents and non-toxic, biodegradable cleaning products.
- Choose sustainable, natural, and organic body products that are chemical-free.
- Buy sheets, rugs, and curtains that use organic fibers produced without toxic chemicals.
