What is the Vice Provost Award for Service?

The Vice Provost Award for Service was established in the Spring of 2004 by the Community Service Office. It was determined that Lehigh University needed a very special and distinct way to recognize, reward and celebrate the contributions of those whose selfless giving represents the highest standard for service and volunteerism. As the most prestigious form of volunteer recognition, this honor is bestowed upon any student, faculty and/or staff member that demonstrates *exceptional*, *unparalleled* service to promote transformation and change.

What is considered Service for this Award? Community Service is the act of engaging in action to meet the needs of others to improve, support and better the surrounding community as a whole, helping to foster social change.

This award recognizes the following types of activities as service:

direct service: activities that address immediate needs

advocacy/activism: activities that identify allies, build common ground, and implement a strategy for changing public policy

community and/or economic development: activities that identify and increase the human and/or economic assets of a neighborhood or community

philanthropy: activities that identify a need and raises monetary funds to dispense for humanitarian purposes.
